

Princeton High School Band Boosters

Minutes for Meeting June 10, 2008

Called to order at 7:00 pm by Tamara Payne, Booster President.

Eight members present including officers: Tamara Payne-President, Denise Splawn-Vice President, Christy Welborn-Treasurer, Mary Butris-Secretary, Sandy Kile, Larry Kile, Bronda Pierce and Jeanetta Busby.

Minutes were reviewed and accepted.

Christy Welborn presented a written treasurer report, summary shows balance of \$8,444.63. Advised Mr. Brewer has a school check to apply to banquet, once deposited total cost paid by boosters for the banquet will be \$297.65. There is also a pending check out for \$50.00 from Christmas, Christy will follow up with administration and report back.

Director's Notes:

Mr. McClure reported on Sounds of Summer Jr. Band Camp will be next week total number to cook for should be approximately 115 including staff. Discussed schedule for meals, lunch at 12:00, dinner 5:00pm and snow cones at 3:00 pm. Advised will need the button maker, Tamara advised there should be plenty of supplies on hand.

Movie will be Thursday evening and dance on Friday.

Tamara advised we need boosters to assist with meals for camp, she sent out an email and only received one response. Menu was discussed and decided on. Pizza will be served on Thursday and has been donated by Christy Welborn's church youth group. Student counselors will receive points toward their accounts for helping with camp.

Tamara advised we need to take a count on the coolers, bought five last year and there were only 4 in the concession stand. There should be a total on seven.

Mr. McClure advised will need help with uniforms in August. Advised they have 154 uniform coats and 150 that needs remeasuring. Have pants we need to see if repairable and possible patch the fabric. Advised should have 30% overage of uniforms which would be approximately 200 uniforms, so may come down to some with out coats, possibly a readjustment in the pit. New jacket wait time is 120-160 days which would be the first of November. Hats need adjustment as well, 15 hats out of inventory mostly larges. Almost all the pants will need re-hemmed. Discussion of working on uniforms the 2nd week of August camp.

Old Business:

Tamara Payne is still working on permission for the carwash on June 28. Mr. Brewer is to check with Admin since Mr. Lovelady has been out of the office. Mary Butris has made up flyers for the car wash and also reminder for aluminum cans collections to help raise funds. For the car wash discussed using the generator the band has to run the snow cone machine. Boosters are to plan on arriving between 8 & 9 am on Saturday, will need buckets, towels and soap and hoses. Tamara will send an email if unable to get approved. Larry Kile offered his power washer and generator if needed. Discussion over Applebee's fundraiser, Mary Butris advised no restriction on number of times as long as date is open. Larry Kile suggested we consider a regular date if goes well. Brief discussion on dates and agreed to check on September 6th and November 1st, agreed price should be \$5.00 in order to sell as many as possible. Mary Butris to call and schedule dates. Discussion over band trip '09 and current balance in account, will have a possible need of three buses which will run closer to \$30,000.

New Business:

Fundraisers are needed had open floor discussion on possibilities, Tamara Payne to check with McDonald's on possible band night. Discussed the possibilities of window decals, sponsors and garage sale, silent auction at Christmas Concert and Santa Shop.

Next meeting will be held in August.
